



2017 Guide to Oregon's Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) Programs

What is a CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a way for the food-buying public to create relationships with small-scale farms. Individuals or groups purchase a harvest share at the beginning of the growing season, which helps to offset the farm's up-front operating costs. By making a financial commitment to a farm, share purchasers become "members" of the CSA. In return, they receive a share of the farm's produce throughout the growing season.

General CSA information

- **Season:** Many CSAs operate through the peak of the season; approximately May-October and range from 14-28 weeks in duration. Buy-in usually takes place early in the season, around March or April. There are some winter CSAs.
- **Pick up/drop off:** Locations and schedules vary by farm. Some farms drop off at farmers markets.
- **Offerings:** Most CSAs include in-season fruits and vegetables. They may also include eggs, cheese, meat, grains, legumes, flowers, plant starts and other items.
- **Size:** Some farms offer a half or full share - choose the right size for you.
- **Market cards:** Many farms now offer a market purchasing card. Buy a card at the beginning of the season, then choose your products weekly at market, deducting the amount from the card.
