POSITION SUMMARY

Portland Farmers Market (PFM) is a nonprofit organization in Portland, Oregon, with approximately 15 full- and part-time staff, including a Market Operations team composed of the Operations Director, three Farmers Market Managers and multiple Market Crew positions. PFM operates five vibrant farmers markets that provide shoppers with a direct connection to our 200 vendors with deep roots in Oregon and Washington. These vendors include farms, nurseries, bakeries, meat and seafood providers, cheese makers and specialty food producers.

Market Crew members provide operational support at our markets. They set up/tear down equipment, conduct PFM sales and services to shoppers and vendors at the market, and work collaboratively with fellow staff members to ensure our market runs smoothly. Successful Market Crew members approach work with a positive, team-minded attitude and can perform tasks in outdoor environments with consideration for timeliness.

SCHEDULE & WORKING CONDITIONS

Saturdays, 6 am – 4 pm, May – November (Possible shifts in December – April, if desired). Location: PSU Farmers Market located at SW Park & Montgomery in Downtown Portland. Additional shifts may be available at:

- Wednesdays, June September at Kenton Farmers Market in North Portland.
- Wednesdays, May October at Shemanski Park Farmers Market in Downtown Portland.
- Sundays, June November at Lents International Farmers Market in SE Portland.
- Sundays, May November at King Farmers Market in NE Portland.

This is a physical, public-facing, outdoor job that requires lifting equipment weighing up to 50 pounds, stepping up and down out of a truck, setting up and taking down canopies, carrying large boxes, working on your feet for extended periods and walking over uneven terrain. PSU Farmers Market operates outdoors year-round, and working conditions may include rain, wind, and hot and freezing temperatures.

POSITION DUTIES

Market Logistics and Safety

- Assist in ensuring that all necessary equipment and supplies are maintained according to policy and otherwise left in good working order.
- Assist in monitoring safety and accessibility concerns during the market's open hours.
- Assist with Durable Dining dish return and waste management.
- Communicate vendor attendance and market logistics to market managers.
- Direct safe traffic of vehicles operating on and around the market site as assigned.
- Report emergencies and safety concerns to the market manager.
- Follow directions to support the market's success, safety, and integrity directly as assigned.
- Follow and offer support for PFM's crisis response plan when necessary.
- Gain a working knowledge of PFM's policies and procedures at the market.

Sales and Service

- Conduct at-market sales and customer service related to token distribution, merchandise, and vendor payments.
- Assist with tracking and recording market tokens, merchandise inventory and vendor payments.
- Maintain supportive relationships with vendors, be familiar with their products and practices and promote their success.
- Provide shoppers with information about methods of payment accepted at the markets, including market tokens, matching programs, and vouchers.

Team Participation

- Work collaboratively to improve and expand the efficiency of work.
- Contribute to the inclusivity of our markets and work environment by building positive relationships.
- Assist with marketing and promotion of the farmers market as assigned.

- Able to repetitively lift up to 50 lbs.
- Sense of humor and ability to go with the flow in fair and foul weather conditions.
- English language fluency.

- Experience working directly with people from diverse racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic backgrounds.
- Experience with customer service.
- Passion for local food and farms.
- Valid driver's license and willingness to learn to drive the market's box truck.
- Ability to speak a second language (in addition to English).
